

## 2010 Wage & Benefit Survey Released

**GREENEVILLE** – The Greene County Partnership *2010 Wage & Benefit Survey* has been released and is available on the Greene County Partnership website.

The objective of this annual Wage and Benefit Survey was to describe the level and distribution of pay and the nature of employee benefits within Greene County, Tennessee. The survey results provide information for wage and salary administration. Information was requested from the manufacturing section which includes industrial producers, distributors and processors.

The questionnaire requested information regarding employee benefits, such as holidays, vacation, sick leave, insurance and retirement plans. The survey also requested wage information for 65 production, supervisory, and clerical occupational classifications in the exempt, nonexempt and hourly categories.

The questionnaire was posted on the Greene County Partnership website to be completed electronically. Each completed survey was reviewed to ensure accuracy and proper completion. In many instances, email and telephone calls were made to clarify or obtain additional information.

Sixteen companies of varying size returned completed survey forms, which gives an adequate base from which to compile a composite of current wage and benefit information.
