Parking

Parking along the front of the building is for unloading or loading only. Please be considerate of other vendors and do not leave your vehicle there while you set up. Unload, move to parking lot, and then set up. Please do not leave your vehicle in the main parking lot on Saturday. These spaces are needed for our customers. The back lot or on the side road beside the football field is reserved for our vendors.

Sales
