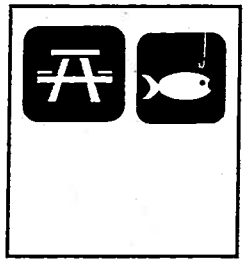

Overview: Picnicking and many other opportunities are available along scenic Paint Creek Corridor. Forest Road #41 parallels Paint Creek five miles between Paint Creek Campground and the French Broad River. Driving for pleasure is one of the most popular activities along the corridor, though bicycling and horseback riding are increasingly more common. Paint Creek is stocked with trout during the summer months, and fly fishing is another favorite activity. Along the corridor, you'll also find overlooks to observe Kelly and Dudley Falls, a warm water fishing pond, hiking trails and opportunities for dispersed camping.

Directions: From Greeneville, take TN 70 south for 11.2 miles. Follow signs to Paint Creek Campground, then turn right onto Forest Road #41 (Paint Creek Road). From Newport, turn left on TN 107, and travel 10.1 miles. Turn right at Rollins Chapel Road and follow signs to Paint Creek Campground.

Fee Information: Camping fee at Paint Creek Campground is \$10 per site per night for single sites and \$20 for double sites.

Requirements: Alcohol prohibited. Facilities are operated on a first-come, first served basis and no reservations are accepted.

Safety: Forest Road #41 is a narrow paved road, used heavily during April through October by a variety of recreationists.

Seasons: Facilities along Paint Creek Corridor are open year round.

Forest Service Recreation Opportunities

Moses Turn Parking: Two tables and a grill. Adjacent to Paint Creek Campground.

Overlook Picnic Area: Four picnic tables, three grills and a vault toilet. Three-tenths of a mile southwest of Paint Creek Campground on Forest Road #41.

Dudley Falls: Viewing and water play area with a vault toilet. Two and one-half miles southwest of Paint Creek Campground on Forest Road #41.

Love Road Picnic Area: (Currently under rehab.) Two and seven-tenths miles southwest of Paint Creek Campground on Forest Road #41.

Falls Picnic Area: (Currently under rehab.) Three and two-tenths miles southwest of Paint Creek Campground on Forest Road #41.

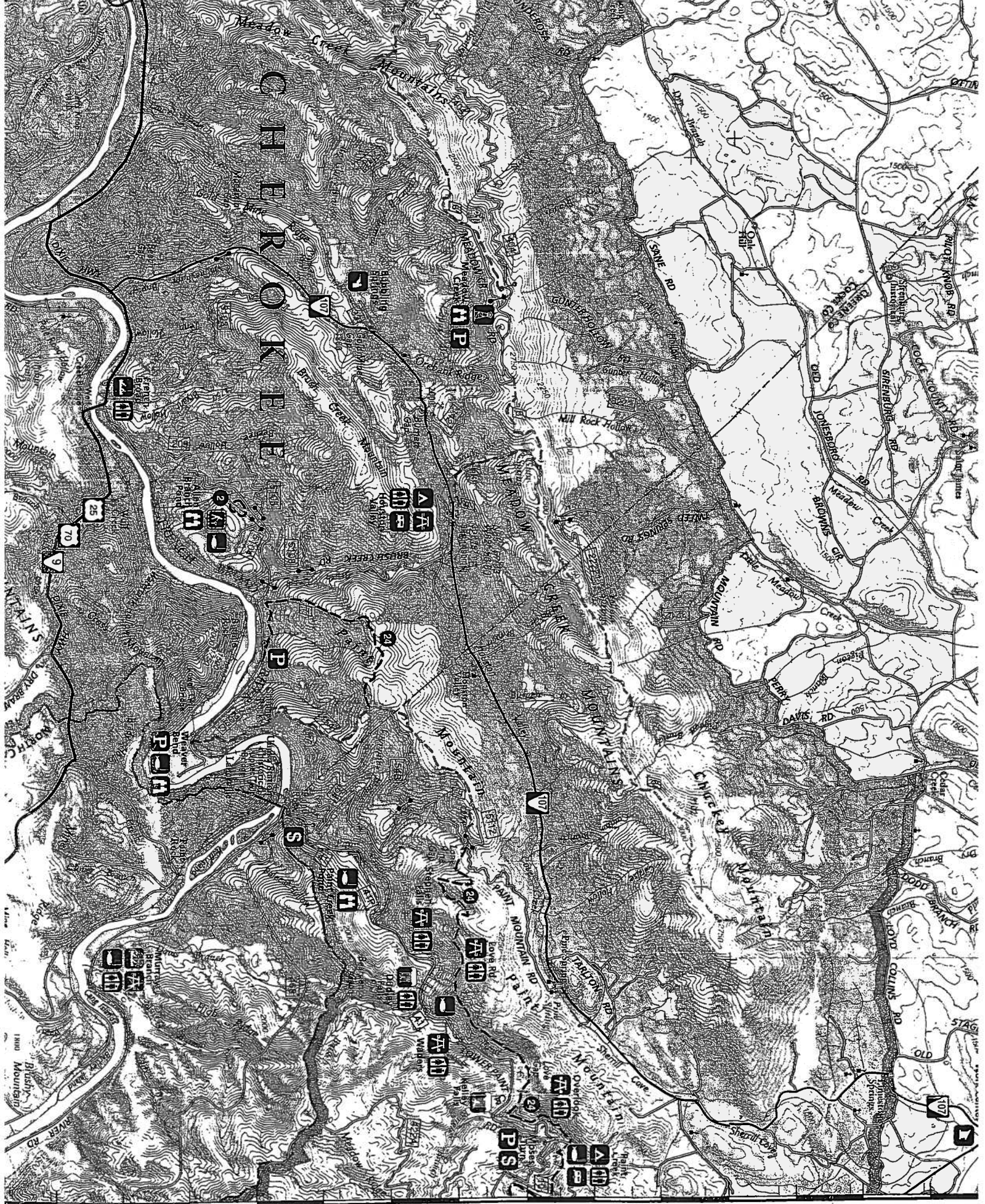
Trails: Paint Creek Trail (#10) and Paint Mountain Trail (#7)
