HOLIDAY LIGHTING SAFETY

- Seasonal lighting is an inexpensive way to put a sparkle in the holidays. Most lights cost from less than one cent to 7.5 cents per string to operate for six hours, depending on the wattage.
- Only use lights and extension cords made for outdoor use.
- Check light strings for fraying, aging and heat damage. Discard damaged strings.
- Plug no more than two or three strings of outdoor lights into one outlet.
- If you are using a ladder, avoid contact with overhead lines when stringing lights.
- Avoid wrapping lights on metallic trees or fencing.
- Use insulated fasteners, rather than metal nails or tacks, to hold light strings in place.
- Avoid running cords through door or window openings where they can be damaged.
- Wear gloves when handling electrical equipment.
- Avoid moisture unless cords are specifically labeled "water-resistant." Keep the connections dry by wrapping them with friction tape or plastic.
- Be sure to turn off or disconnect holiday lighting before leaving the house or retiring for the night.
